

Old Cutchogue Burying Ground
Conservation Treatment Workshop
May 4 & 5, 2018

The objective of the May 2018 *Conservation Treatment Workshop* was to repair and straighten headstones and footstones facing Harbor Lane, which borders the west side of the site. This section of the burying ground dates from the mid- to late 19th century and contains early gravestones of Cutchogue's African American residents. All of the stones are of white marble.

Conditions include: severe tilting, which puts stones at risk of falling and breaking; detachment/broken stones with no apparent losses; and buried or sunken stones. In several cases, more than one condition was noted on a single stone (e.g., broken and buried). A total of 8 headstones and 6 footstones were treated over two days by stone conservator Joel C. Snodgrass, with the assistance of volunteers.

In addition to the conservation treatment of headstones and footstones, a granite fence post facing the Main Road was also repaired as a demonstration project for Boy Scout Joe DePinto, who has chosen repairing and straightening the 45 stone posts that face Main Road and Harbor Lane as his Eagle Scout project. The stone posts were installed in the mid-19th century to support a wooden picket fence, which later deteriorated. Approximately half of the stone posts will require repair, and all need cleaning. The project is scheduled for summer of 2018.


